

Hill Country Pregnancy Care Center History & Timeline

1987

HCPCC Begins!

Center began offering pregnancy tests, lay counseling and material assistance (2 volunteers) in a small upper floor location on Boerne's Main Street.

2009

HCPCC moves to new location (439 Fabra St.) to accommodate increasing service needs.

2013

Client Education Expands

HCPCC begins its "Earn While You Learn" program and adds Childbirth Classes. Individualized prenatal and parenting classes help clients "earn" additional maternity and baby necessities



2004

Partnering with CareNet

HCPCC becomes a Care-Net medical facility offering ultrasounds, STD testing, and pregnancy tests along with expanded client education, post abortion services, and community education.

2010

Community Outreach

HCPCC expands its focus and begins preventive education through classes taught by our nurses in elementary, middle and high schools.

2015

Cultural Outreach and STD Treatment Starts

A Hispanic Program started so all services would be culturally appropriate and offered in Spanish. Also, STD treatment was added to the testing service.

Men's Mentorship Program Begins

2016

New Satellite Offices open

Two new satellite offices are opened in Comfort & Bulverde. Services at both locations grow quickly.



Church Advisory Council Begins

Reps from area churches gather quarterly to share partnership news about HCPCC

2019

New Nanny's Boutique opens

HCPCC constructs new boutique building on site in Boerne to give our clients a wonderful "shopping" experience with the Earn While you Learn Program.

2020

Virtual Options & TCP Service added

Options for virtual classes and online intakes begin. Class numbers and completion rates double! HCPCC becomes Texas Community Partner, assisting clients to with additional health and financial benefits.

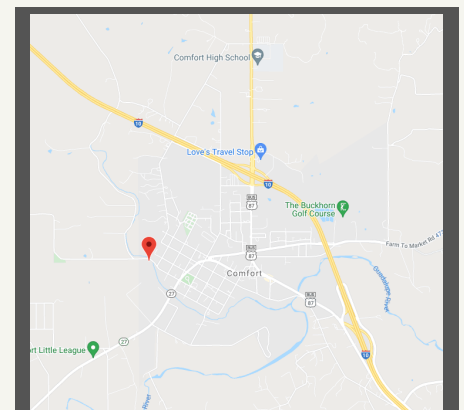
