A New Outlook

We recently met a young woman (we will call her Abigail) with dreams and plans for her future; an unplanned pregnancy was not one of them. Frightened at the prospect of delivering and raising a child, Abigail began researching options online and clinics to terminate her pregnancy. She believed this was the best of the difficult options ahead. A friend approached her and asked if Abigail would consider coming to HCPCC before she made her final decision (her friend was a former HCPCC client and felt loved and cared for with us). Abigail agreed to come.

After the initial meeting, Abigail thanked us, said she did appreciate how she felt loved and cared for by us, but still planned to terminate the pregnancy. Due to the new laws on abortion in Texas, local clinics and termination options were unavailable, so she prepared to travel outside of Texas for her procedure.

However, God had a different plan.

Abigail had a free ultrasound scheduled with us a couple days following, and when her appointment time came, her boyfriend (and father of the baby) came with her. That moment was a life changer! Baby was extremely active and the heart beat was VERY strong. Immediately, the room was filled with smiles! In the discussion following, her boyfriend let Abigail know that he would like to help her and support her. Together, they learned about the valuable resources HCPCC provides and how we would walk alongside them on their pregnancy journey. After visiting the Boutique and receiving some maternity and baby items, the couple decided that raising the baby was the right option for them. They left with a **new outlook** and excitement about the future and their new little one. The couple has already completed several prenatal and parenting classes!
